Council Delegate Job Description

Each service unit shall be entitled to elect delegates and persons to become delegates for the unexpired term should vacancies occur. The number of delegates shall be based on the girl membership as of June 30 each year, according to a formula established and administered by the board of directors. Regardless of the number of girls in a service unit, every service unit shall be entitled to elect at least one delegate. Delegates shall be elected for a term of one year or until their successors are elected.

Girl Scouts of Swift Water Council Bylaws article three

Basic Requirements: Registered Girl Scout 14 years of age or older, affiliated with Girl Scouts of Swift Water Council and participating within the assigned Service Unit. Interested in the policy issues of the Council and willing to participate in meetings.

Responsibilities:

1. Represents the constituency at the annual business meeting of the council, which is usually held in November.
2. Participates in special meetings as requested by the President of Girl Scouts of Swift Water Council.
3. Provides communication on policy issues to constituency members as requested by the Board of Directors.
4. Initiates and submits to the board, proposals directed toward the fostering and improvement of Girl Scouting within the Council.
5. Gathers input and reaction to proposed plans and policy matters being considered by the board of directors.
6. Identifies external and internal trends for the board's use in formulating corporate goals.
7. Performs such other duties as may be requested by the board of directors.
